

SHOE BOX DIORAMA

Use a shoe box to build a diorama related to your book. Follow the instructions below to put it together.

Inside box:

The inside of your diorama must reflect an important scene from the book and the background much match the setting. Use materials from around your home to build a creative and well-organized scene.

Box Lid:

Title and if present, sub-title of your book. Note, if you have a shoe box with an attached lid, consider using the inside of the lid as well. See the example of the piano diorama to the right.

Front Side:

Author's name

Right Side:

Include the title of the book, author's name, number of pages, and the number of stars you would give it if you were a book critic. The maximum number of stars is five.

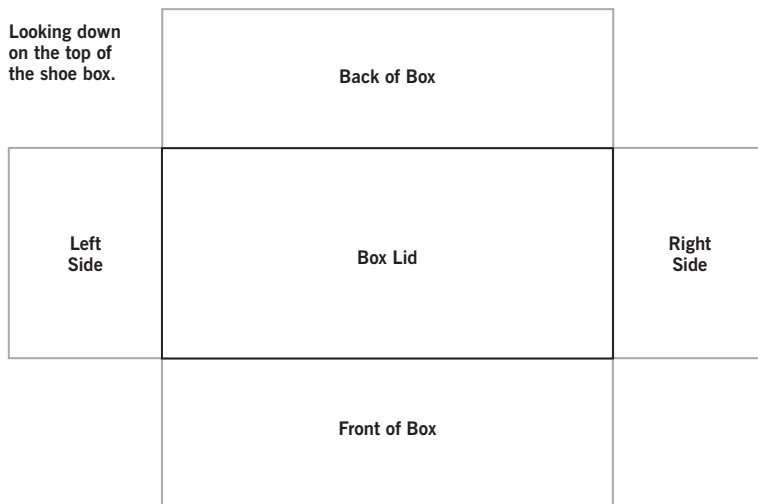
Left Side:

List the main characters and write one to two sentences about each. Also, describe the setting of the book in three to four sentences.

Back of Box:

Write a one-paragraph summary outlining the plot of the book. Make sure it includes the main conflict and solution in the book. Also include one to two sentences describing the diorama scene inside the box.
